
His campaign and early presidency focused on providing opportunities for the youth, including job creation and entrepreneurship support.

WHO WOULD HAVE THOUGHT?



Hanifa Adan



Police Brutality during the protests against the Finance Bill resulted in death of over 50 the young protesters to-date; police brutality, exacerbating public anger. illegal detentions, Instances of abductions, wrongful arrests, and use of live bullets have been reported. Several young Kenyans have faced abductions detentions with trumped-up charges or no charges at all.

Some have been wrongfully arrested due to sharing similar names, while others have had to carry trumped-up charges after being assaulted.

These cases have unified the public and garnered support from organizations like the Law Society of Kenya (LSK), led by its President Faith Odhiambo, have been at the forefront and has brought justice to those who faced injustices. Citizens have supported protesters through donations, legal aid, medical services, and proper farewells for those who died.

Despite the ongoing economic and social unrest, the IMF remains committed to supporting Kenya's efforts to achieve inclusive and sustainable growth and improve the living standards of its citizens.

As of January 2024, the IMF has provided Kenya with funding totaling approximately \$3.9 billion. This support also aligns with the government's broader reform and governance agenda, .
